Accommodations: We have nine newly renovated guest cabins of various size which accommodate between 2-8 people. Guest cabins are right on the water, with screened porches, skylights and picture windows which face down the lake. All have gas ranges, gas refrigerators, gas lights, and woodstoves with plenty of dry firewood. Kitchens are fully equipped with sinks, pots, pans and eating utensils. Gravity-fed water tanks supply spring water to spigots in front of each cabin. There are six common shower houses with plenty of hot water and flush toilets. Beds have new firm mattresses, linens and blankets. Each cabin has at least one double-bed, and the larger cabins have a separate bedroom for privacy.

American Plan : \$130 per adult /per day Children ages 1-17.....\$6 per day/ per year of age
-Cabin and Full home-cooked breakfast and supper served in lodge dining room, and a packed lunch.

Modified American Plan: \$100 per adult / per day Children ages 1-17.....\$5 per day/ per year of age
- Cabin and home-cooked supper. Guests furnish their own breakfast and lunch.

Housekeeping Plan: \$75 per adult /per day. Children ages 1-17.....\$3per day /per year of age
-Cabin with fully equipped kitchen as described above.

All Plans... include use of canoes and kayaks on Nahmakanta Lake, rowboats and canoes at all the backcountry fishing lakes, access to all hiking trails, and free trail maps and area information.

Boats with Motors: 6HP Motors on 14' Boats with Pfd's \$50 per day

Access: Nahmakanta is located in a vast wilderness area, approx halfway between the towns of Greenville and Millinocket, and 15 miles southwest of Mt Katahdin. We are 2.5 driving hours from Bangor, and are accessible by well maintained gravel roads from two different directions.

From Greenville: Drive northeast 18 miles on paved road to "Kokadjo". Beyond Kokadjo, gravel roads lead 25 miles into camp. There are no toll or road use fees via Greenville/ Kokadjo

From Millinocket: Drive south 18 miles on Rt 11, then turn right onto the gravel "Jo-Mary road, which leads 27 miles into camp. There is a road use fee collected at a gate near the Rt. 11 turnoff.

.....Driving time from both Greenville and Millinocket is approx 1.5hours. We have "NLC" signs at all turns along the gravel roads. A road map will be sent with your confirmation.

Float Plane: Access by float plane is also available, from Millinocket (*Katahdin Air Service 207-723-8378*) or Greenville (*Jacks Air Service 207-695-3020*).
